LOCATION

The Chase Center on the Riverfront is located in the newly revitalized and redeveloped Wilmington Riverfront. The Chase Center is located mid-way between New York City and Washington, D.C., approximately 100 miles each direction, on the I-95 corridor .

POPULATION

The greater Wilmington, Delaware area hosts more than 5 million visitors each year for cultural attractions, meetings and events. Delaware has plenty of tax-free shopping and dining, and boasts some of the lowest lodging taxes in the Mid-Atlantic area.

More than 6.5 million people reside within a 50-mile radius, and 2.3 million people reside within a 25-mile radius of Riverfront Wilmington. New Castle County's population is 750,000 with a workforce of 266,800. Nearly 33,000 people are employed in the city of Wilmington.

TRANSPORTATION

Major highway access includes I-95, I-495, I-295, and the New Jersey Turnpike / Delaware Memorial Bridge. An average of 200,000 cars drive past the Riverfront on I-95 every day. Another 28,000 cars travel through the Riverfront area on the Walnut and Market Street Bridges.

Amtrak and Septa Rail access at Wilmington's train station, the nations' eleventh busiest railroad station. More than 700,000 people travel on Amtrak and another 350,000 take Septa through Wilmington each year.

Air access at the Philadelphia International Airport, 25 minutes by car on I-95, and New Castle County Airport, for private aircraft and charters is only 10 minutes by car.

Local Dart Bus and Trolley service is available in and around Wilmington.

ACCOMODATIONS

There are over 6,000 hotel rooms in the greater Wilmington area, including 750 rooms within a mile and a half of the Chase Center on the Riverfront.

ATTRACTIONS

The Brandywine Valley is rich with historical and cultural attraction including museums, estates, public gardens as well as award-winning golf courses, horse and NASCAR racetracks, beautiful beaches and sightseeing.
